Death of Aaron – Num. 33:38-39 (~July 16, 1407 BC)
Moses' Deuteronomy sermons (mid Jan., 1406 BC)
 Death of Moses – Deut. 34:1-7 (early-mid Feb., 1406 BC)
 Israel enters Promised Land – Josh. 3:1-17 (~March 26, 1406 BC)

12 spies sent into Promised Land. Israel sentenced to wander in the wilderness 40 years. Every male over 20 will die in the wilderness – Num. 13:1-14:35 (1444 BC)

Moses is born – Ex. 2:1-2 (1526 BC)

God calls Abram to the land of Canaan (the Promised Land) – Gen. 12:1-9 (2091 BC)

Isaac, the child of the promise, is born – Gen. 21:1-7 (2066 BC)

Joseph sold into slavery in Egypt – Gen. 37:1-28 (1898 BC)

Jacob & family move to Egypt with Joseph – Gen. 45:1-47:12 (1876 BC)

Jacob (Israel) is born – Gen. 25:26 (2006 BC)

Joseph is born – Gen. 30:22-24 (1915 BC)

Joseph dies – Gen. 50:26 (1805 BC)

Israel's Exodus from Egypt – Ex. 12:29-41 (1446 BC)

Israel enters the Promised Land – Josh. 3:1-17 (1406 BC)
